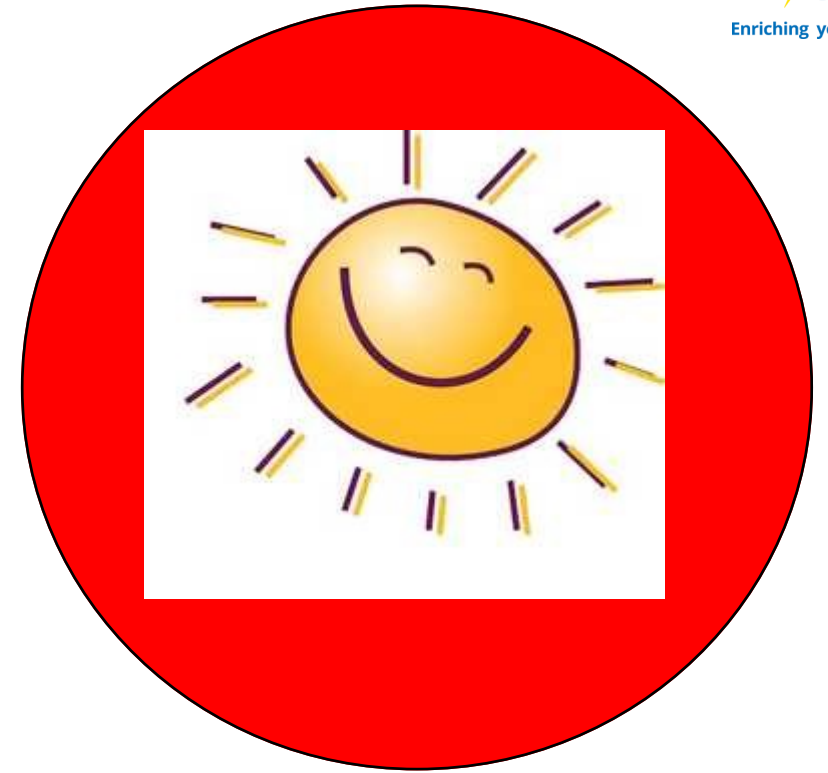

What is an Independent Visitor?

“An Independent Visitor is a volunteer who is someone who is there for you if you need them. They are there to listen, advise and support you.”

Definition by a young person who had an IV.

They are someone who will encourage you to try new things.

They are someone you can have fun with.

They are there just for you.

Confidentiality—please remember our service is **confidential** unless you or another child is **at risk of harm**.

Other things you should know

If you would like an Independent Visitor, ask your social worker about having one.

Independent Visitors are not social workers, parents or carers and they are not part of social services.

We make sure they are suitable people and like young people.

They have said they will be an IV for at least one year.

If you have an Independent Visitor and are not happy with them you must let us know.
